

Hoover MAP-R and MAP-M Testing in May

All students will be taking the Measures of Academic Progress for Reading (MAP-R) and the Measures of Academic Progress for Math (MAP-M) in the month of May to meet a requirement by the Maryland State Department of Education (MSDE). The data collected from both the fall 2020 and spring 2021 MAP-R and MAP-M will serve as diagnostic tools for the school and for the annual reporting of the All In: Equity and Achievement Framework in the Fall as well as serve as the pre assessment for the 2021 summer school. All students in grades 6, 7, and 8 will **take the assessments virtually on two virtual Wednesdays:**

- MAP-R Wednesday, May 5 from 12:30-3:00 (in lieu of charge up)
- MAP-M Wednesday, May 26 from 12:30-3:00 (in lieu of charge up)

All students will log-into **Connect Time classes** to take both MAP-R and MAP-M. Please be sure to have students attend these test sessions as there is little time or opportunity to make-up the tests. In addition, please ensure students are well rested and have had lunch prior to the test. All **cameras must be on** during testing as students must be monitored by their teacher at all times.
