It is a day to reflect on working for fair outcomes for individuals through employment, social dialogue, social protection and fundamental principles and rights at work. It is also a day to focus on social injustices in the world (systemic racism, gender inequality, etc.) and to work towards creating solutions.

Description of the Activity: In this activity, you will explore and reflect on issues of social justice and ways to take action by answering four (4) questions. The response to each of the four (4) questions is required to be at least 3-4 sentences in length in order to earn SSL credit.

- 5) Question One – Can a person's race or gender affect how they are treated in the workplace or society? How and why? ****Response is required to be at least 3-4 sentences in length in order to earn SSL credit.****
- 6) Question Two – Identify and describe a social injustice in your school, community, your country, or the world-at-large. ****Response is required to be at least 3-4 sentences in length in order to earn SSL credit.****
- 7) Question Three – What can you do as a student to address the social injustice you have described? ****Response is required to be at least 3-4 sentences in length in order to earn SSL credit.****
- 8) Question Four – How will you use your knowledge of the described injustice to motivate a call to action for others in your community? ****Response is required to be at least 3-4 sentences in length in order to earn SSL credit.****
